

CUBE Storage: 'Fort Knox' of the North

VICTORIA – Legal issues are causing organizations to hold onto records for longer periods of time, causing a sharp increase in the need for storage space. CUBE Global Storage, for-

mally known as **Data Base File Tech Group**, is a local company founded by **Michael Weston** in 1980, which provides clients with access to one of the safest, state of the art facilities in the country.

CUBE is currently located in the **Milwest Centre**, which was built to withstand hurricane-force winds of up to 135 km/h.

The building was also designed to be functional after 9.5 earthquakes, 1.5 times the normal specifications for such a facility. (The largest earthquake recorded was 9.3 on the Richter scale, during the early 1900's in Alaska.) One of the most disaster-resistant facilities on the planet, CUBE has earned the reputation as the 'Fort Knox' of the North.

CUBE Global Storage has been securing and saving business operations for more than 25 years. Under the original name, CUBE has worked with over 400 clients who store physical assets and online information. Governments, universities, hotels, banks, private collectors and small to large businesses rely on CUBE's expertise, ease of access, client confidentiality and state-of-the-art security systems.

The one million cubic feet of storage space is so secure that it has been named the safest build-

ing in the province and is also designated as a post disaster centre for the Victoria region by **Public Safety Canada**. Organizations can also store the equipment and materials they would need to set up an instant operational centre onsite, should a disaster affect their office.

"Discretion, service and security are the number one priorities in our business," says Weston. "However, we realize that in the past we have been very quiet about what we do and the level of service we provide.

"We can handle the storage needs for large corporations and governments to individuals who would like to store a single box, antique, piece of art, or computer files for as long as they need, yet ensure it is immediately accessible or in the case of computer files, replaceable, when they need it. I believe our new branding helps us to market ourselves more effectively."

Growing markets include the home business market, who may have invaluable company documents stashed in their garage or under their bed, to universities which now have to hold onto student transcripts for 55 years. "CUBE Global Storage also reflects our ability to work with clients all over the world," he says.
